## Required Admissions Material

- Letter from employer confirming employment in the construction and building industry (must verify at least **two years** of experience).
- Copy of high school diploma, GED or college transcript.
- Photo ID.
- All programs require an essay. Details are available during open enrollment.

## Eligibility Requirements

- All applicants must be currently employed in the construction and building industry with a minimum of **two years** experience in the field of your desired program.
- Must be a high school, GED or college graduate.

## Required Fees

- \$100 Registration Fee due **every semester**.
- \$75 Membership Fee due **every year**.
